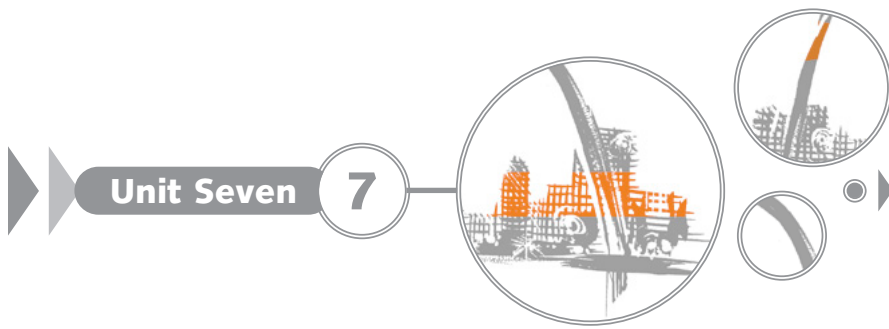

Teacher's notes

Going to the Cape – Summary

In scene 7A, Jennifer, Luis and Josh talk about what clothes they are taking to Cape Cod. In scene 7B, Josh is filling the car with sports equipment, and he is unaware of the irony when Luis asks him if it really is best to “travel light.” In scene 7C, they travel to Cape Cod, and Josh and Jennifer’s parents’ beautiful house. In scene 7D, Shawna and Sara have also arrived in Cape Cod. Sitting in a restaurant, Sara tells Shawna that she didn’t break up with Brian yet. Josh, Jennifer and Luis arrive in the same restaurant and Josh persuades Luis to speak to Sara. In scene 7E, Josh, Shawna and Jennifer go for a walk and get lost. In scene 7F, Luis and Sara are walking on the beach. Sara lies to Luis, saying that Brian is no longer her boyfriend. Luis is just about to kiss Sara when the others arrive.

1 Before you watch

▶▶ Cultural note

- Ask the students to read the cultural note.
- Pre-teach the expression *vacation resort* (a place, often specially created, for tourists to go on vacation).
- Have students list vacation resorts in their country.
- Have them make individual lists of clothes.
- Put the ideas on the board and ask them to add any new words to their lists.

2 Watch for main ideas

38:12 – 45:22

- Pre-teach any new vocabulary in the scene titles, as necessary.
- Ask students to read the titles before watching the video.
- While watching, pause the video between scenes (see **Video Script**), if necessary.
- The students should be able to perform this task after watching the whole unit.

3 Watch for details

Scene 7A: 38:29 – 40:05

- Ask the students to look again at the list of clothes they made.
- You may need to pre-teach some words, e.g. *tank top* (a shirt with no sleeves and a low neck).
- Have them complete the boxes with what they remember. It may be better to do this activity in pairs. Check their answers.

Answers:

Jennifer	Luis	Josh
T-shirts, tank top, jeans, sweater, tennis shoes, jacket, pants, shirt, sandals, bracelet	T-shirts, jeans, sweater, tennis shoes, jacket, pants, shirt, bathing suit, hat, tie, shoes	T-shirts, jeans, shorts, sweatshirt. (He also takes tennis shoes but doesn't mention them.)

▶▶ Scene 7B: 40:08 – 40:32

- Since this is a very visual task, ask the students to watch the scene before they begin the exercise.
- Explain to the students that it is not necessary to write down the names of the items but to recognize the sports as represented by the equipment.
- Have the students check (✓) the boxes. Check their answers.

Answers: biking, surfing, windsurfing, fishing, water skiing

▶▶ Scenes 7C: to 7F: 40:35 – 45:22

Note: Scenes 7C to 7F have the same structure. These scenes are important in terms of the story and it is essential that the students understand what is happening. The task focuses the students’ attention on the key points and also gives them an opportunity to express their ideas more freely.

- Have the students think about their answers before watching each scene again. Check their answers after each scene.

▶▶ Scene 7C: 40:35 – 41:38

Suggested answers: 1 Josh, Jennifer and Luis are at Jennifer and Josh’s parents’ house. 2 They are looking at the ocean, deciding what to do, etc. 3 Jennifer says, *Let’s go (and) get something to eat.*

▶▶ Scene 7D: 41:41 – 43:46

Suggested answers: 1 They are in a restaurant / café. 2 They are looking at Sara and Shawna. 3 Josh is saying, *Talk to her.*

▶▶ Scene 7E: 43:49 – 44:17

Suggested answers: 1 They are on the beach. 2 They are looking at a map. 3 Shawna is saying, *We’re lost!*

▶▶ Scene 7F: 44:22 – 45:22

Suggested answers: 1 They are on the beach. 2 They are talking. 3 Sara is asking, *Are you going out with anyone?*

4 After you watch

Language focus: suggestions

- a ● Tell the students the meaning of *Let’s ...*. It is used for suggestions that include the speaker. It is followed by the infinitive without *to*.
- Have the students match the sentences with the suggestions.

Answers: 1e 2c 3a 4f 5d 6b

- b ● Have the students read the sentences and make their own suggestions.
- Obviously, there are no right or wrong answers for this exercise.

Suggested answers: 1 Let’s run / take a taxi. 2 Let’s play a game / watch television. 3 Let’s have a picnic / go out to eat. 4 Let’s go to the ocean. 5 Let’s buy a new TV.

Scene 7A: 38:29 – 40:05

Josh: Oh, no, man! It's the Cape. On Cape Cod, you don't need such formal clothes.

Luis: You don't?

Josh: No, it's very casual. Here's what I'm bringing ... some T-shirts ... a sweatshirt ... a pair of jeans ... and some shorts.

Jennifer: Is that all you're bringing?

Josh: Yeah. I travel light.

Luis: Light?

Josh: Oh, yeah, without a lot of stuff. Light!

Scene 7B: 40:08 – 40:32

Josh: OK, now ... Just a few more things ... windsurfer ... boogie board ... wet suit ... fins ... beach chair ... mountain bike ... and fishing equipment. Now we're ready to go!

Luis: So, you travel light, huh, Josh?

Josh: Travel light! Absolutely!

Scene 7C: 40:35 – 41:38

Jennifer: This is the Sagamore Bridge ... we're crossing over the Cape Cod Canal.

Josh: There's the windmill store. We're almost there!

Jennifer: We're here!

Luis: This is great! What a nice house.

Jennifer: Welcome to Cape Cod!

Josh: Now, let me see, the key is around here somewhere. Ah, got it.

Jennifer: This is the kitchen ... this is the living room ... and this is the boat!

Josh: Oh, we love it here. It's great ... er ... so let's go for a walk. Take a look at the ocean.

Luis: Sure! I'd like a walk after two hours in the car.

Jennifer: I'm sorry, I'm really hungry. Let's go get something to eat.

Josh: "I'm Jen, let's go get a tofu burger." Come on.

Scene 7D: 41:41 – 43:46

Shawna: Ah ... The weather is so beautiful out here.

Sara: It'll probably rain tomorrow!

Shawna: No, it won't. Come on, let's have a beer and some food. Hmm ... I'll probably just have a burger ... Hey, what happened when you broke up with Brian? How'd that go? Was he really sad?

Sara: Brian was ... er ... I didn't do it. I didn't break up with him.

Shawna: Oh, Sara. He thinks you're still his girlfriend!

Sara: Yeah. I just couldn't do it. It was impossible. But I'll talk to him on Monday. Definitely on Monday.

Josh: Luis, hey, look who's over there.

Luis: Who?

Josh: That girl you like. You know, the one who gave you her phone number.

Luis: Sara? No thanks, Josh. She already has a boyfriend. Forget it.

Josh: She's not with her boyfriend now.

Jennifer: Come on, you guys. Let's just sit down. There's a table right there ...

Josh: No, hold on, Jen. This is important. Look, Luis. Go over there. Talk to her! Go. Go!

Jennifer: Stop it, Josh. He doesn't want to talk to her.

Luis: Well, I don't know. You're right, Josh. She isn't with her boyfriend now. I'll be right back.

Josh: And ... action. He's walking to the table. She's looking at him. She's smiling at him. He's talking to her. She's talking to him. He's sitting down ... Don't you think I'm funny?

Jennifer: Come on, let's just get a table. I'm hungry.

Scene 7E: 43:49 – 44:17

Shawna: We're lost.

Josh: Well, according to the map ... oh ... according to the map ...

Jennifer: We're not on the trail anymore Josh.

Shawna: Yeah, like I said, we're lost.

Josh: Well, look, let's just go down there to the ocean.

Jennifer: All right, let's run, I need some exercise anyway.

Josh: I'll race you!

Scene 7F: 44:22 – 45:22

Luis: I was surprised to see you last night.

Sara: I was surprised, too. Er ... and happy.

Luis: I uh ... I really like being with you, Sara.

Sara: I like you, too, Luis. A lot ... but uh, right, uh, now I'm really confused about ... things.

Luis: Things ... like your boyfriend?

Sara: Well ... he's not my boyfriend now. We're not going out anymore.

Luis: Oh, really?
